GENERAL

1. **Race Programme.** The races, which are normally held at the Army Championships, are shown in Table 1. Individual races may be held as part of a team race (eg the 10 km sprint biathlon is a "team and individual" race).
2. **Championship Races.** The "championship races" for each major trophy (eg Kentish Cup, Princess Marina Cup etc) are shown in Table 1. In relays and the patrol race the total team time (all 4 skiers) is recorded. In other team races the times of the best 3 skiers from a team of 4 give the team time. If only 3 skiers start the race the time of all 3 is added together.
3. **Finishing Place.** The "finishing place" is the finishing place (relative only to those competing in each trophy) as recorded in the official race results. In all competitions any team which starts in a race but fails to finish or is disqualified, will be given a points score of the last team to finish the race plus one. If a team does not start a race, for any reason whatsoever, the team will be given a points score of the last team plus two.
4. **Deciding Race.** In the event of a tie the final place will be decided on the best place in each race as follows:
 - a. **Nordic Inter Unit Competitions (ie Kentish / SAS Cups and Div Champs):**
Patrol Race - 4 x 7.5 km Biathlon - 15 km XC - 10 km Biathlon Sprint - 4 x 10 km XC
 - b. **Nordic Individual Competitions:**
20 km Biathlon - 15 km XC - 10 km Biathlon
 - c. **Nordic Inter Corps Championships:**
10 km Biathlon - 15 km XC - - 4 x 7.5 km Biathlon
 - d. **Nordic Inter Service Championships:**
20 km Biathlon, 15 km XC
 - e. **Princess Marina Cup:**
Patrol Race - Team Downhill - 4 x 7.5 km Biathlon Relay - 15 km XC - Team Super G
➤ If one of the above races is not run the substitutes (for priority are):
4 x 7.5 km Biathlon Relay for Patrol Race; Super G for Downhill: 4 x 10 km XC for 15 km XC; Team Slalom for Team Super G.
5. **Inter Corps and Inter Service Championships.** In the Inter Corps and Inter Service Championships (not the SAS Cup) the finishing places of those **scoring** (Rule 1.8 & 1.9) are added together. (Eg if the RN finished 1-2-3-4 and the Army 5-6-7-8, the points would be RN 1+2+3 (6), Army 4+5+6 (15)).
6. **BBU Club Championship.**
 - a. The BBU Club Championship is based on positions in the following races:

- b. Points are awarded to the top 130 Men and top 30 athletes in all other categories in each class of each race, on a descending scale as per the IBU / FIS points scoring system. Points are awarded in the following classes:
- Senior Men
 - Junior Men
 - Senior Novice Men
 - Junior Novice Men
 - Women
 - Novice Women
 - Youth Men
- c. The best 5 scores from a maximum of 7 races are totalled to give the final positions.
- d. The BBU Club Championship is open to all members of the BBU, however Men and Women (Senior) athletes who have raced for GBR in the World Cup team are not eligible until 3 years after their last season in the team and those in the European Cup team are not eligible for 2 years. (An athlete who last raced World Cup for GBR in 2002 can not compete until 2006, an athlete who last raced European Cup for GBR in 2002 can not compete until 2005).

ALL ROUND SKIING - THE ARMY CHAMPIONSHIPS

7. The Champion Skiing Team of the British Regular Army is the unit team whose finishing places in the following races total the least:
- **Alpine:** Giant Slalom, Slalom, Super G, Downhill.
 - **Nordic:** 15 km Cross Country, 10 km Biathlon Sprint, 4 x 7.5 km Biathlon Relay, Military Patrol Race.

The four races in each discipline are the Army Team "Championship Races".

- **The Champion Skiing Team of the British Army is awarded The Princess Marina, Duchess of Kent, Cup (SK 36).**
- **The runner up to the Champion Skiing Team of the British Army is awarded The Canadian Land Forces' Trophy (SK 19).**

The first and second teams (ten competitors in each) will receive individual trophies.

PRIZE LISTS

8. **Sponsors' Prizes.** From time to time sponsors donate prizes. These may be allocated to races as decided by the AWSA and/or Race Committee bearing in mind any particular wishes of the sponsors
9. **National Prizes.** The AWSA is privileged to run a number of National races on behalf of the BBU and BSSF.
10. **Medals and other prizes.** In addition to the prizes listed in table 2 below, Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be presented to all AWSA, Inter Corps, Inter Service and National prize winners. Salvers, tankards, glassware etc may also be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee, occasionally in lieu of a medal. Medals etc may also be awarded to the best novice, best junior etc at the discretion of the Race Committee. A full prize matrix will be issued on arrival at the Army Championships and will be regularly updated by the Race Secretary.
